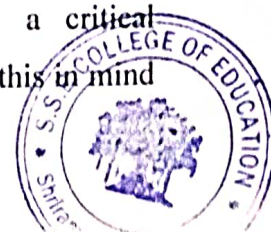
1. Teach To Learn and Learn to Teach.

1. Reading for enhancing Communication skills.

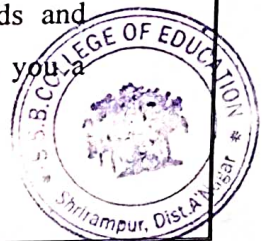

1. Connecting the students with community during Lockdown 2020-21

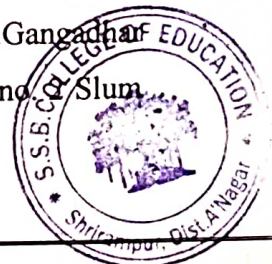

a. Covid Vaccination Drive.

SSB College of Education, Shirampur organized institute level 'Covid-19 Vaccination Drive' on 08/10/2021 at the college campus. Later on, Government of Maharashtra implemented the very idea under 'Mission Yuva Swasthya', in collaboration with Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. Principal, Dr. M. S. Pondhe, motivated the students, teaching and non-teaching staff for the vaccination. 33 students with teachers were vaccinated in the Drive. In the next drive, after 03 days, 32 students with teachers were vaccinated. Total participated: 65 (Male: 12, Female: 53)

b. Mask Distribution Drive in Shrirampur City
