B. Ed. Second Year Practice Lessons

a) Lessons (6 lessons):

The student teacher has chosen a unit from the school subject in collaboration with both the school teacher and the faculty. They have created a lesson plan for that particular unit and delivered the lessons for a minimum of three periods, while being guided and observed by the school teacher or teacher educator.



In the Internship the student teachers completed following activities

(a) Lessons (6 lessons):

The student teacher selects a unit from the school subject in consultation with the school teacher and faculty. They prepare a lesson plan for that unit and teach it for a minimum of three periods under the guidance and observation of the school teacher or teacher educator.



(b) Plan of evaluation:

The student teacher has formulated a Unit Plan that incorporates formative assessment (for each lesson plan) and summative evaluation (a unit test upon unit completion) for the aforementioned chosen units. They have created and administered the unit test, along with crafting a blueprint, model answers, and a marking scheme for the administered test.
