The Government of Maharashtra has made Teacher Eligibility Test mandatory for becoming a teacher at primary and upper primary level from year 2015. Also, the Central Teacher Eligibility Test has been made mandatory for becoming a teacher in a Central government sponsored School.

Therefore, the number of students who pass the Teacher Eligibility Test is low.

Swami Sahajanand Bharati College of Education has experienced teachers. Also the college library is well equipped with reference books. Hence a one week workshop is conducted every year in the college. Because of that the students from rural areas can get the guidance of teacher eligibility test examination easily.
