NSS Outreach programs & National Priority Programs (NPP)

As envisioned by the institution's vision, the NSS Outreach programs and National Priority Programs (NPP) aim to develop social responsibility in student teachers. Over the span of 5 years, the institution has conducted a total of 151 Outreach Activities and 55 National Priority Programs (NPP).

Highlighted Outreach Activities & National Priority Programs:

1. Mask Distribution Drive:

The NSS Unit and Students' Welfare Cell of SSB College Of Education, Shrirampur, organized a Mask Distribution Drive in Shrirampur City to control the spread of COVID-19 and raise awareness about SMS (Social Distance, Mask, and Sanitation). People were also informed about the precautions to be taken regarding the pandemic situation of COVID-19 during the mask distribution.
